Members are reminded that renewals returned as “undeliverable” by the USPS will result in termination of membership.

The March meeting was attended by more members than expected. Many were submitting their renewal forms and several folks were submitting applications for new membership. Once again, steel “swingers” were discussed although these targets were approved by the Board several months ago. As soon as the targets are fabricated and the weather permits their installation, swinger “gongs” will be a feature of the rifle range at 100, 150 and 200 yards. Members are reminded that no steel-core, armor-piercing or ammunition exceeding a muzzle velocity of 3,000fps are to be fired at these targets as target damage will occur and safety will be compromised. Members are also reminded that those who intentionally damage targets are compromising –your—range and that those who inflict such damage to the targets will be required to compensate WFGA for new targets, lose their membership privileges, or both.
